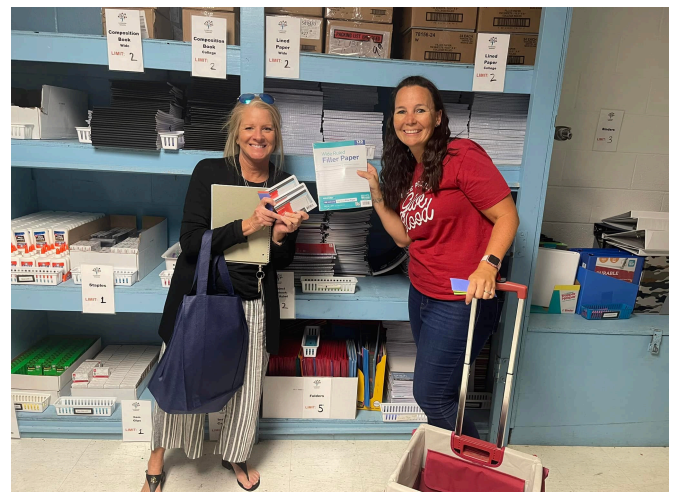

Outcomes

- 98% of teachers who shop at Tools 4 Schools report spending less of their own money on their classroom.
- Student interest in pursuing more STEM classes increased by 32% in grant-funded classrooms
- 100% of students participating in the Future Ready Clay: Financial Literacy Project gained confidence in personal finance
